Dr. Massimo Mari, is an economist and technologist at the National Council of Research - DIITET. He holds a Master's degree in Economics from the University of Rome "La Sapienza", where his thesis focused on sustainable forest management and biomass utilization for energy production. He pursued a postgraduate Master's degree in management of energy resources at SAFE, specializing in waste-to-energy technologies and co-incineration benefits in industrial plants. From 2008 to 2010, Massimo advised on national renewable energy and energy efficiency policies at the Italian Ministry of Environment.
